- 100 **Segura Viudas "Aria" Brut N.V.** 25
Clean, crisp, and refreshing, this Spanish Cava would put many a more expensive bubbly to shame.
- 101 **Ruggeri & C. Prosecco Gold Label** 34
Vibrant and intensely fruity. Gently sweet and fresh on the palate.
- 102 **Roederer Estate Brut, Anderson Valley** 38
Crisp and elegant with complex pear, spice and hazelnut flavors. Fresh and lightly fruity with great finesse.
- 103 **Mumm Napa Brut Rose N.V.** 41
Soft, elegant, and seductive, you don't want to drink this "Pink Champagne on ice!"
- 104 **Moët & Chandon Imperial N.V.** 77
This awe-inspiring Champagne used to be called White Star, now it is simply Imperial. Fabulous!
- 105 **Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin Brut Yellow Label N.V.** 97
Lavishly textured, and luxurious on the palate. Another words, "the good stuff."
- 106 **Perrier Jouët Brut Rosé N.V.** 125
Soft, sexy, and impeccably balanced. Pure, unadulterated pleasure!
- 107 **Moët & Chandon Cuvée Dom Perignon 1999** 260
The man, the myth, the legend of all Champagne! We need not say more.
- 108 **Louis Roederer Cristal 2002** 390
The ultimate in breed, class, and sophistication. Dare you be a player?

CHARDONNAY

- 120 **Four Vines "Naked" Un-oaked 2008** 24
"Naked" because this refreshing Chardonnay does not get the oak treatment. Clean, crisp, and delicious!
- 121 **Au Bon Climat, Santa Barbara 08** 34
Winemaker Jim Clendenen is "The Mind Behind" some of California's great Chardonnay. This wine would even make a Frenchman happy! (well maybe)
- 122 **Ferrari Carano, Alexander Valley 06** 52
Rich, full bodied, and layered with personality, much like Chip, Flash, and Matty!
- 123 **Robert Mondavi Winery, Napa 06** 36
We lost an Icon when the old man Mondavi passed away a couple of years ago, but the legend continues. This is a classic Napa Valley Chardonnay at its finest.
- 124 **Mer Soleil, Monterey 2007** 65
Big, bold, massive (get your mind out of the gutter!). This Chardonnay is a full throttle, ultra rich, in your face wine, that will have the "WOW" effect on you.
- 125 **Melville Estate, Santa Rita Hills 2007** 34
As elusive as the Great White Whale, this Santa Barbara Chardonnay is already coveted by many a connoisseur. Rich, intense, and complex, with a mineral component that is only found in the finest wines.
- 126 **Cakebread, Napa 06** 74
Layers and layers of flavor, would you expect anything else from the name?

SAUVIGNON BLANC

- 130 **Pomelo, California 2008** 24
We call the Pomelo fruit "Jabong" in Hawaii, kinda like a local grapefruit. That is what this terrific Sauvignon Blanc is like. Loads of citrus flavors, making it utterly refreshing.
- 131 **Sterling Vineyards, Napa 2007** 34
This wine never goes away, as it is a Napa Valley Classic! Others can only sit back, and watch from afar.
- 132 **Chalk Hill, Sonoma 2007** 65
The formula for this great Sauvignon Blanc, started as an idea on the black board. Now you can have it a hundred times and not get tired of it.
- 133 **Rusack, Santa Barbara 2008** 41
This beautifully dry white wine is perfumed with aromas of honey dew melon, pears and spun sugar. These aromas merge with flavors of Meyer lemon and pineapple on the palate and finish with a sensation that is both fruity and crisp.

OTHER WHITE WINE DISCOVERIES

- 140 **Conundrum, California 07** 44
Puzzled on the name? Let's just say that this amazing blend of many different white grapes has been duplicated by many, but none have been successful. This stuff is just plain delicious!
- 141 **Luna Vineyards Pinot Grigio 07** 34
Equally as stylish and sleek as any of the great Italian versions but richer, this Napa Valley Pinot Grigio rocks!
- 142 **CF Wines Euro-Asian Riesling Germany 07** 23
Created by a Japanese (Master Sommelier Chuck Furuya), and produced by a German (Gunderloch), this wine is as multi-faceted as it is multi-cultural. Killer stuff!
- 143 **Santa Margherita Pinot Grigio Valadige 2007** 44
The standard for which all others are measured. Slug this down with one of our Pizza's and you'll be saying "grazie."
- 144 **Mionetto Moscato 2007 Italy** 23
Sweet and floral, with the tiniest of bubbles, and a finish that is as soft as a baby's pillow.
- 145 **Melville Estate Viognier "Verna's" 08** 38
Delicious and delectable, like biting into a mélange of fresh peach and honeysuckle.

WORLDLY ROSÉS

- 150 **Beringer Vineyards White Zinfandel California 08** 20
Sweetly textured and pretty in Pink. It's okay for the guys to drink it too (we won't tell)
- 151 **Domaine de Fontaine Corbieres Rose "Gris de Gris" 08** 29
Look out into the ocean, close your eyes, and sip on this wine. It will put you in a trance. Nothing sweet or fruity here, just an awesome, dry rose that you'll want to drink by the bottle.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

- 160 **Evil, Australia 07** 24
This Aussie Cabernet starts off so innocent, but because it is so exuberantly soft and fruity, strange things happen to those who seek it.
- 161 **Esser, California 07** 24
One of the great quaffers on our list. This just tastes so good, but costs so little. What a deal!
- 162 **Dynamite Vineyards, California 05** 38
The rich, ripe, cabernet fruit will explode on the palate, then leave you with a sense of awe.....
- 163 **Caymus Vineyards, Napa 07** 109
Simply one of the most sought after and coveted Cabernets in all of America. A true masterpiece. Wanna make a friend or two?
- 164 **Silver Oak Wine Cellars Alexander Valley 04** 99
Another superstar in the Cabernet world, Silver Oak is timeless. It will leave you with completely content, until you have the next bottle!
- 165 **Robert Mondavi Winery, Napa 06** 45
Still, one of the most revered, and trusted Cabernets anywhere in the World. You will never be disappointed with it, end of story.
- 166 **Provenance, Rutherford 06** 66
Winemaker Tom Rinandi is one of the funniest people around. This wine on the otherhand, is as serious as it gets. Rich, dark, and brooding, with a finish that lingers until eternity.
- 167 **Opus One, Napa 05** 238
Two Icons in the world of wine decided to make a wine together back in 1979. Little did Robert Mondavi and Baron Phillipe de Rothschild dream, that this would change the World. This is still (30 years later) one of the most coveted wines of all!
- 168 **Stag's Leap Wine Cellars "Cask 23," Napa 04** 240
Open the vault, then be enthralled with the beauty and sophistication of one of the Greatest Cabernets anywhere in the World. It is that good!
- 169 **Diamond Creek "Red Rock Terrace" Napa 05** 200
Like a Diamond in the ruff, this Cabernet is indeed a rare find. Big, dark, mountain fruit at it's finest.
- 170 **Chateau Lascombes Margaux, France 04** 94
Wine guru Robert Parker rated this wine 94 points. To us, it tastes like 100! Live long and prosper.
- 171 **Château Pichon Longueville Comtesse de Lalande, Pauillac, Bordeaux 05** 286
One of the Worlds greatest Cabernets, bar none. The ultimate expression of breed, class, and nobility. Truly memorable.

MERLOT

- 180 **Blackstone Reserve, Sonoma 06** 31
An iron fist, in a velvet glove! Rich and intensely flavored, yet soft, plush, and velvety. A Classic.
- 181 **Rutherford Hill, Napa 04** 45
Wonderfully layered and structured, but as smooth as our black velvet interior. Napa Merlot at it's finest.
- 182 **Provenance, Napa 05** 47
Mega-intense, yet soft, supple, and alluring. Want to impress your date? Here's your ticket.
- 183 **Stag's Leap Wine Cellars, Napa 06** 56
Seriously endowed, a Merlot that will be the envy of all others.
- 184 **Duckhorn, Napa 05** 130
No explanation needed here, Duckhorn helped to put this grape on the map.

PINOT NOIR

- 190 **CF Wines, Santa Barbara 07** 40
Soft, sexy, sleek, and seductive. This Pinot Noir is absolutely breath-taking!
- 191 **Melville Estate, Santa Rita Hills 07** 53
Extraordinary fruit, impeccable winemaking, a "Mona Lisa" of artwork.
- 192 **Au Bon Climat "La Bauge au Dessus" 06** 58
Produced by the master of the Pinot Grape, Mr. Jim Clendenen. Impeccably balanced, and smooth as silk, simply beautiful.
- 193 **W.H. Smith, Sonoma Coast 2007** 49
Bill and Joan Smith are crafting some of the greatest examples of Pinot Noir in the New World. Discover this one soon, before everyone else does!
- 194 **Patz & Hall, Sonoma Coast 2007** 68
Shows spectacularly ripe berries, cherries, anise, bacon, sandalwood and spices, wrapped into smooth, ultra-fine tannins. For all the richness, it finishes dry. A big wine, but balanced and nuanced.
- 195 **Costa D'Oro "Oro Rojo" Santa Maria 2006** 78
If this were a white wine, it would be like liquid gold in a glass. In this case, it is Red Gold! Killer Pinot Noir, it's hard to imagine anything better.
- 196 **The Ojai Vineyard, Solomon Hills 2005** 73
Like a diamond in the rough. Something that you would hope to find once in a lifetime. Rich yet soft, lavishly textured and multi-faceted.
- 197 **Domaine Serene "Evanstad Reserve" Oregon 06** 117
One of Oregon's treasures, Domaine Serene truly stands out in a world of mediocrity.
- 198 **Perrot Minot Chambolle Musigny Vieilles Vignes 2007** 199
Got Glass? If so, I'll be right over! You will be seduced, then enthralled, with this thrilling example of one of the World's Great Wines.

OTHER RED WINE DISCOVERIES

- 200 **Four Vine's Zinfandel "Old Vine Cuvee" 07** 23
The ultimate Hamburger wine, but at a "slider" of a price! A fruit juicy red, with explosive fruit flavors.
- 201 **Rosenblum Zinfandel Paso Robles 06** 45
Any connoisseur of great Zinfandel will know this wine. The all American grape, meets one of the finest winemakers. The result? Pure magic!
- 202 **Luchador Shiraz Barossa Valley, Australia 05** 28
Nacho Libre would have been proud! Don't wrestle around trying to decide on a wine, this is it!
- 203 **Penfold's Cabernet Shiraz Bin 389, Australia 06** 59
It's a very "gudday" when one can enjoy this Australian masterpiece. Cabernet and "sheeraz," blended to perfection.
- 204 **Antinori Chianti Classico Riserva Marchese, Tuscany 04** 54
Simply put, a damn good Chianti! You don't have to wait for a special occasion, live a little!
- 205 **Antinori Tignanello, Tuscany 06** 148
The very first "Super Tuscan" creation, and the one whom everyone else now follows. Sangiovese, Cabernet, and Merlot, vinified to perfection. Enjoy this "Under the Tuscan Sun."
- 206 **Marchesi di Barolo Barolo, Piedmont 04** 78
Out of the cellar comes this Italian treasure. Richly flavored and mega-intense, with a nose redolent of tar, tobacco, and rose pedals. You won't spit this one out!
- 207 **Edmeades, Zinfandel, Mendocino 07** 44
Delicious and creamy. The tannins are silky smooth and the finish is long and memorable.
- 208 **Michael David, Petite Petit, Lodi 07** 46
Ample aromas of ripe plummy fruit. On the tongue, the fruit is sweet, and the texture is smooth.
